2017 SUMMARY OF EVENTS (CAZ)

2017 has come and gone, and it is time to reflect on the journey we have travelled together. We thank those who have walked with us and supported us to attain the goals the Cancer Association of Zimbabwe (CAZ) set out for 2017. The year was full of exciting events and we thank God for taking us this far. CAZ appreciates and value your support and partnership. We look forward to working with you in 2018.

Together, we managed to accomplish the following in 2017:

2017 Highlights

- 2 553 people were reached through external wellness, lectures and exhibitions (34% increase from 2016)
- 2 182 women and 18 men were screened for breast cancer at the Cancer Association and during outreach programs (30% increase from 2016)
- 1 536 women were screened for cervical cancer (18% increase from 2016)
- 1 359 men were screened for prostate cancer using the rapid test; the prostate-specific antigen (PSA) (71% increase from 2016)
- 2401 clients were seen by CAZ nurses at the Cancer Association and during hospital visits (14% increase from 2016)
- 272 clients received chemotherapy drugs donated by Higherlife Foundation and Stanbic Bank (30% increase from 2016)
- 351 people were reached through public lectures at CAZ on various cancer topics (5% increase from 2016)
